<b>County of Lambton Community Health Services &amp; Child Health and Dental Services Department</b>	Prenatal and postnatal services for families with children 0-17years of age.	<b>Child Health</b> - Preconception, prenatal and postnatal education, parent education and workshops, breast feeding support, child development, school readiness and vision screening. <b>Healthy Babies Healthy Children</b> -a voluntary program that emphasizes prevention and early intervention to help children from before birth to age six to get a healthy start in life. <i>Enhanced 18 Month Well Baby resources and information.</i> <b>Dental Services</b> -for children 17 and under with no dental insurance & not covered by Ontario Works. <u>Children in Need of Treatment (CINOT)</u> - only immediate/urgent dental care, must first be screened by oral health staff. <u>Healthy Smiles Ontario (HSO)</u> -must have family net incomes less than \$20,000 yearly.
