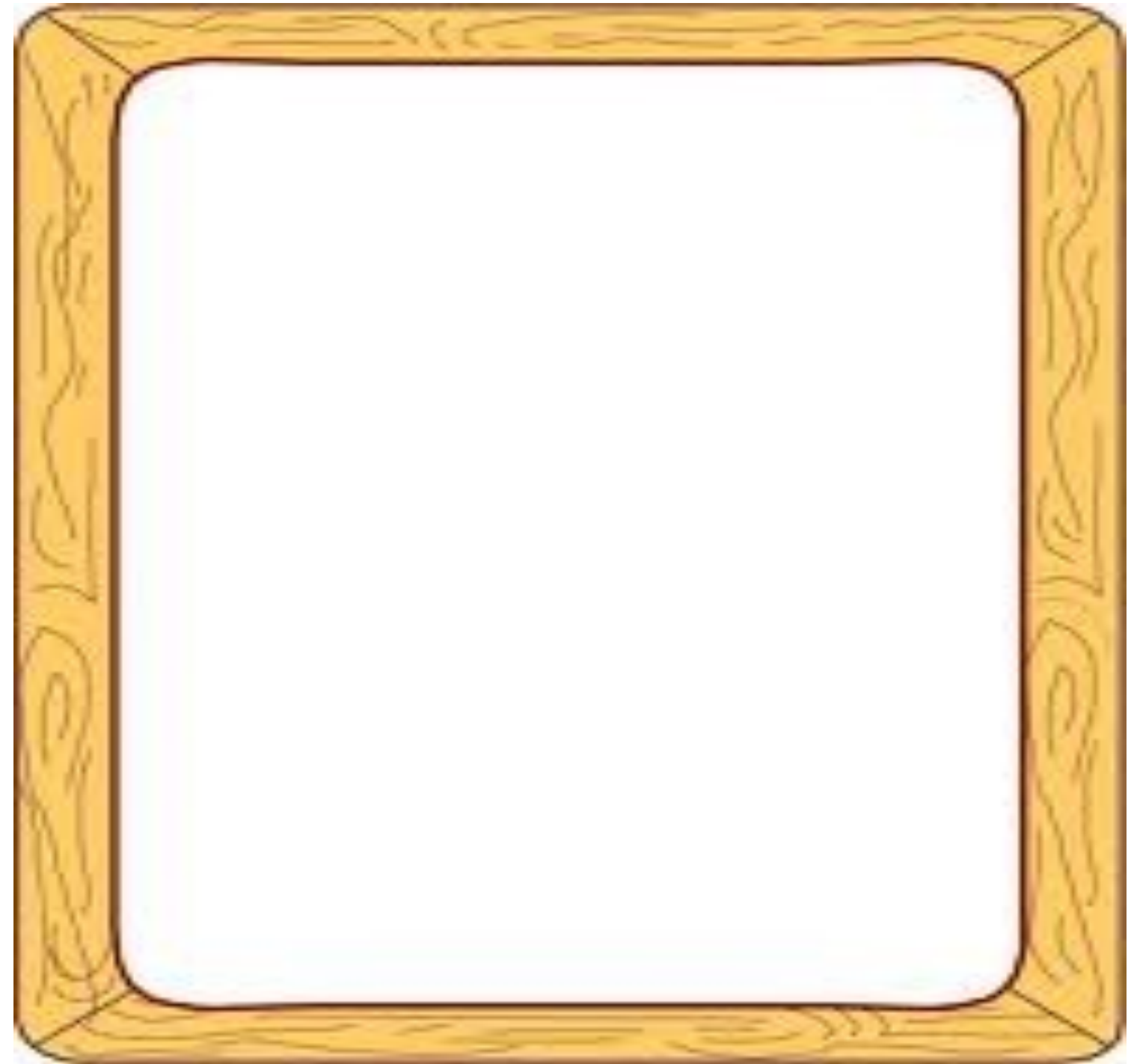

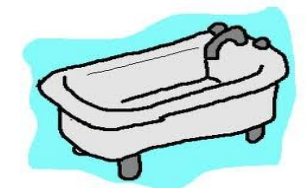


Right # 12: The Right to Equal Access

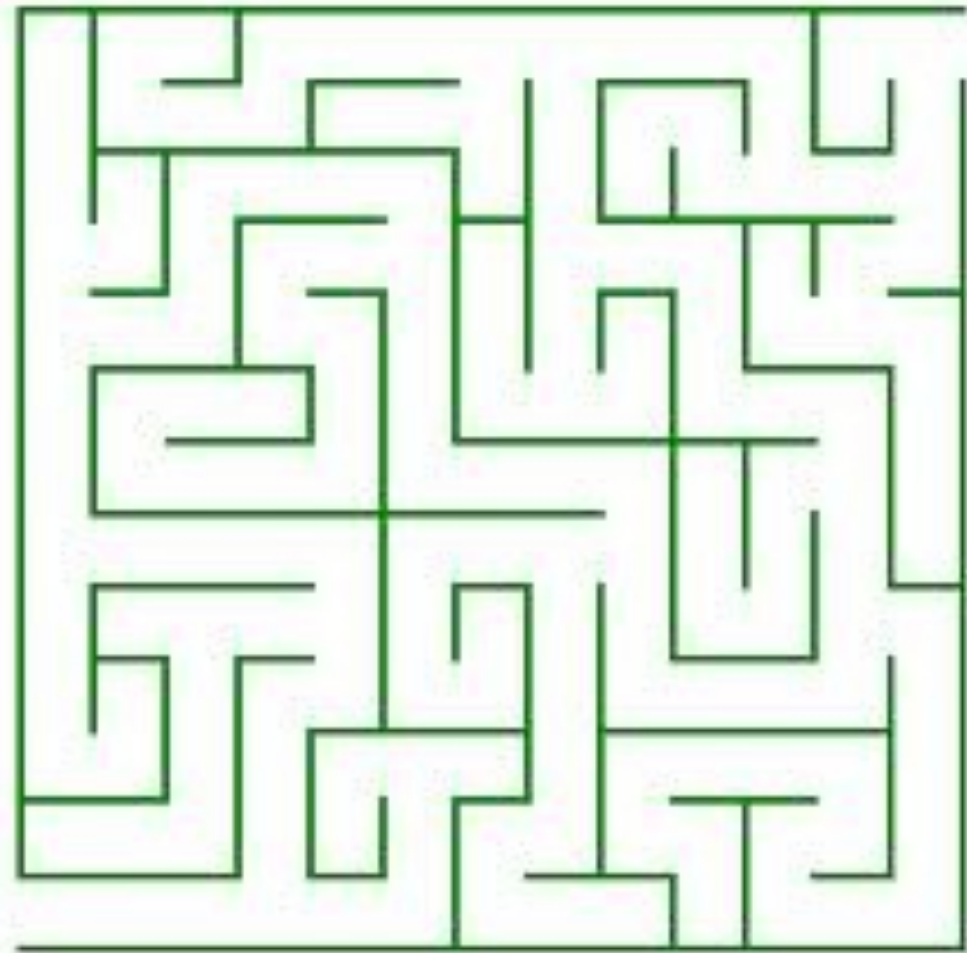

Help the boy find his way home!



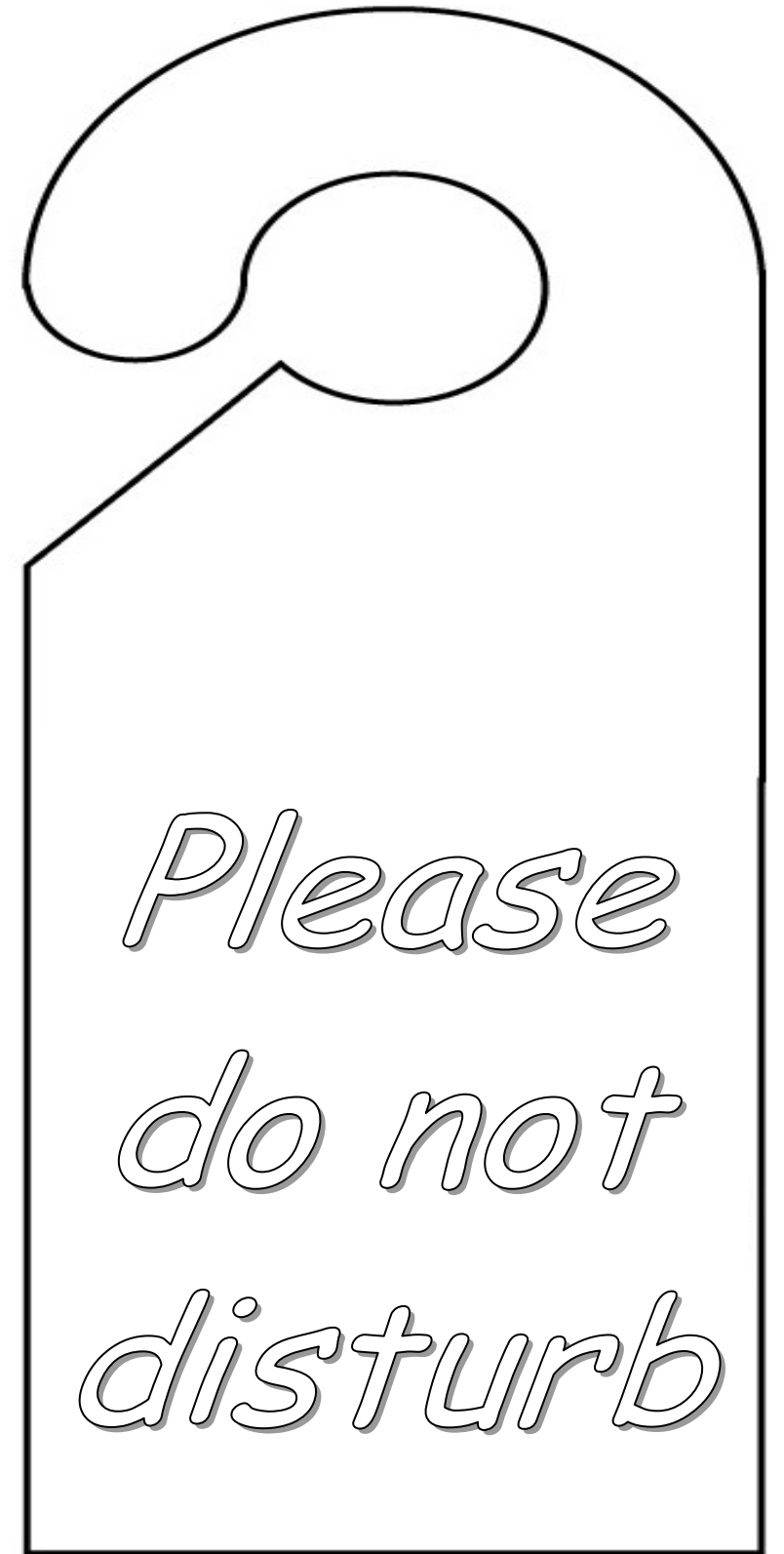
Right # 2: The Right to a Nurturing Home

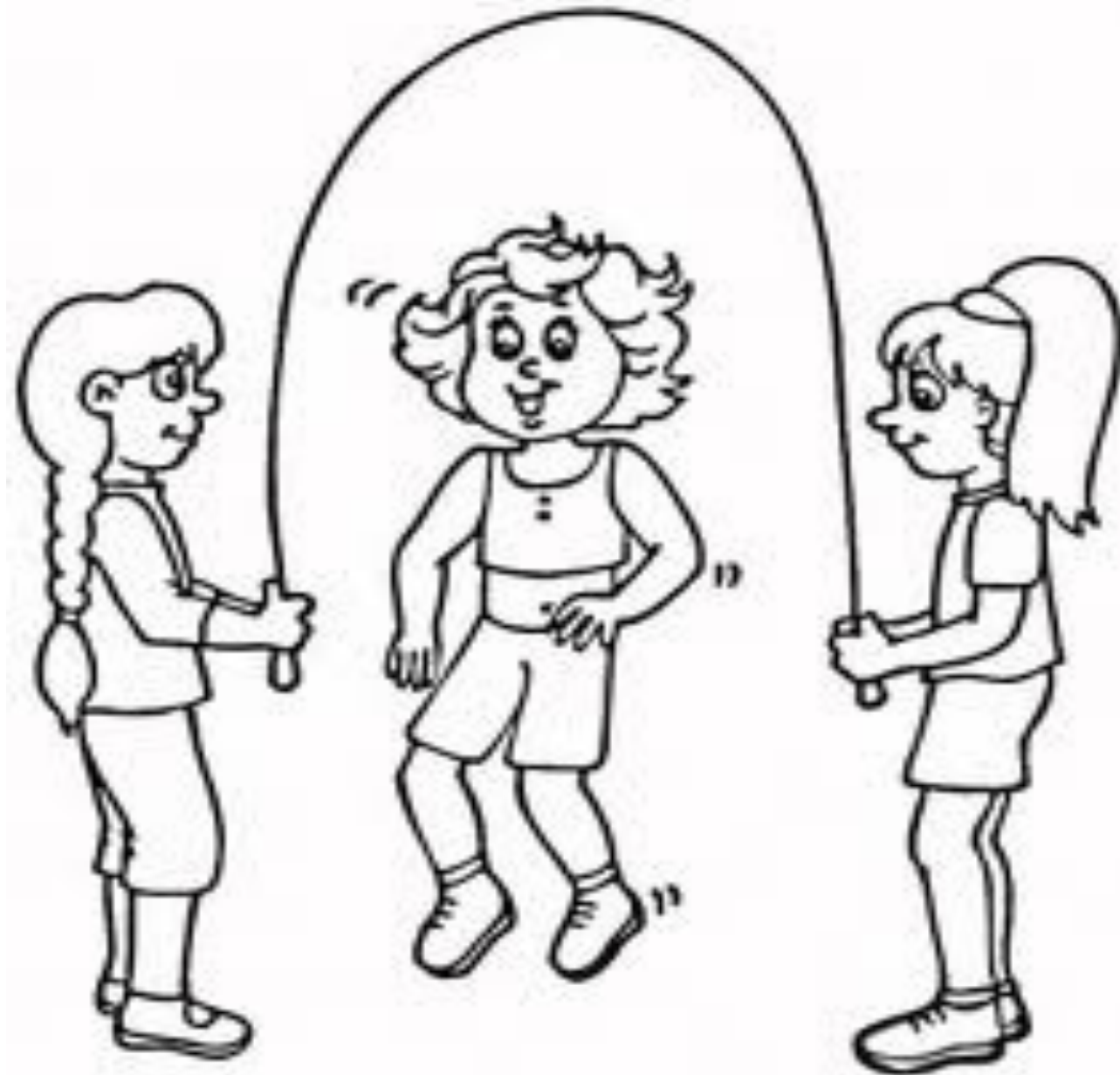


Right # 11: The Right to Privacy

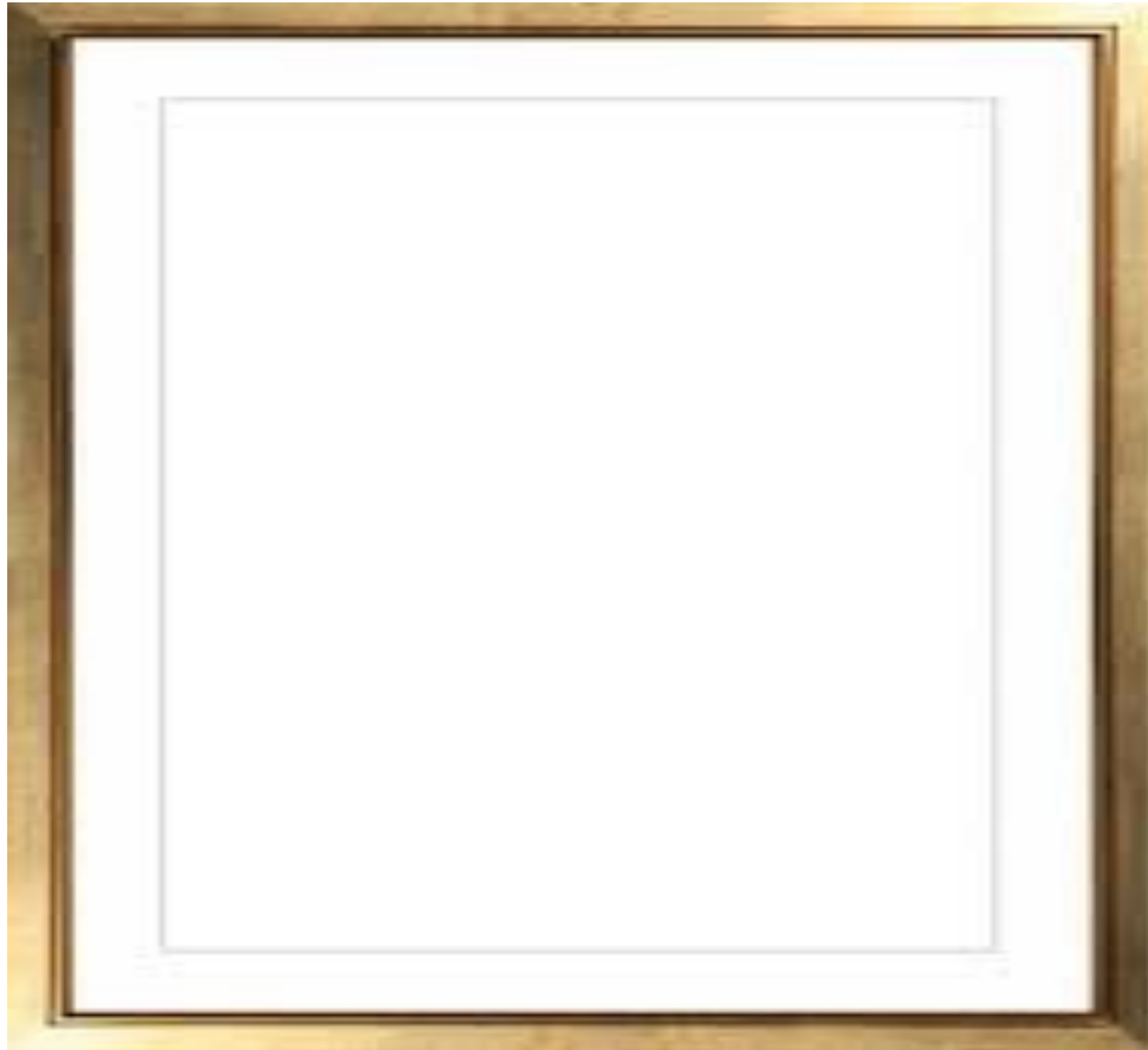

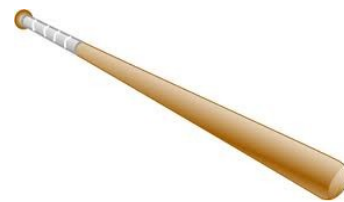

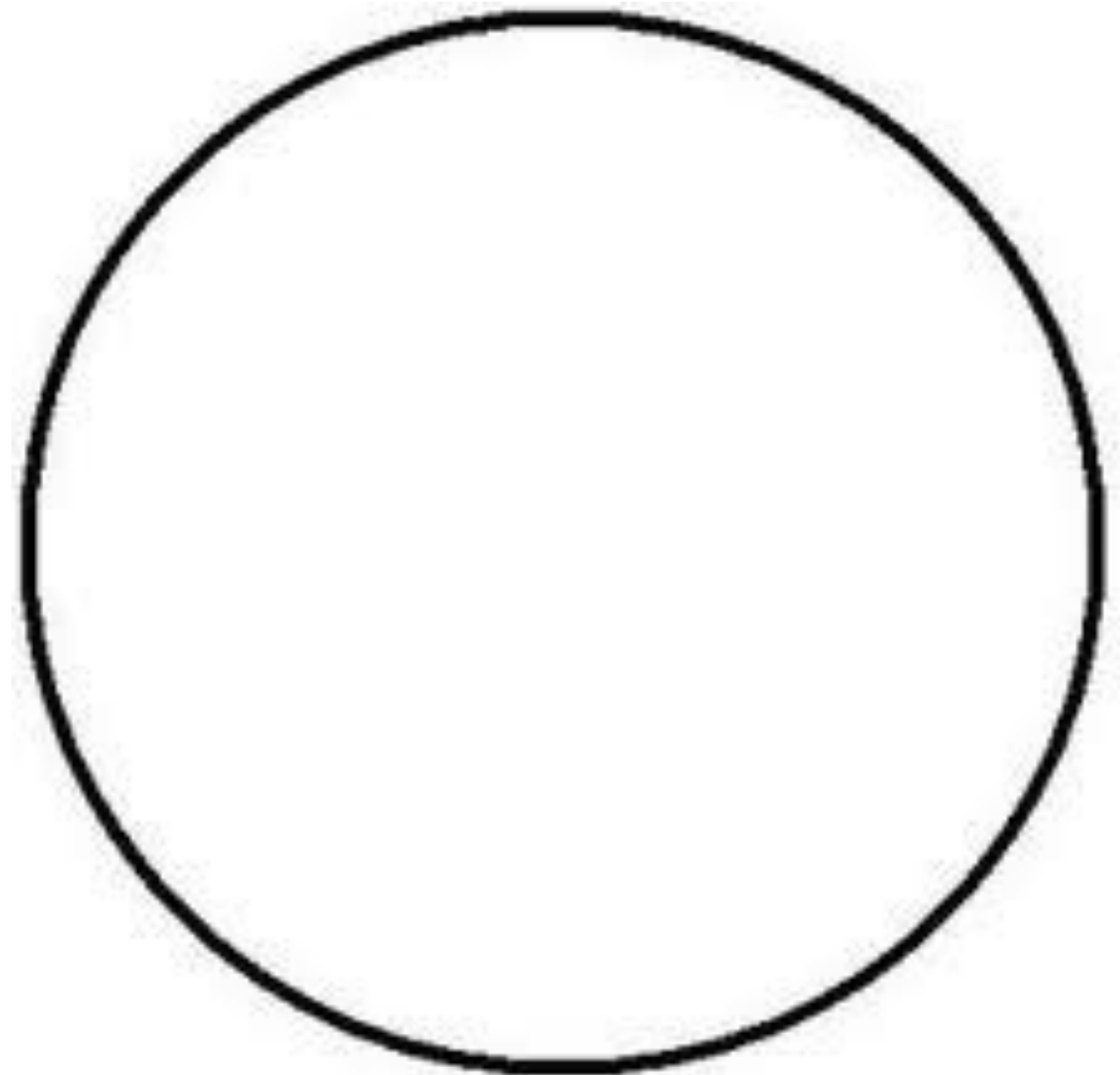
